Reboot Laptop Wishlist

Our ideal laptop would meet the following criteria:

- Powers on, displays some kind of info (text, login screen, etc... as long as screen is not black)
- Has Windows 7 sticker or later
- Has been sanitized/cleaned thoroughly
- Has little or no damage to the display screen (scuffs, cracks, dead pixels, etc.)
- The hinges of the clamshell design are still attached securely
- Battery holds some charge
- Includes power adapter
- Has hard drive caddy if applicable
- No screws, keys, or other components missing

Even when the above conditions cannot be met, or your computer cannot be refurbished for resale, donations of many kinds still provide participants in our recycling team opportunities to disassemble electronics.

We also accept:

- Wires & cables
- Computers working or non-working*
- Computer parts
- LCD/LED monitors
- Printers (preferably laser)
- Laptops (please attach the laptop power supply with masking tape/rubber bands if possible)
- Keyboards and mice
- Smartphones and cell phones
- Game consoles, cartridges and accessories (Atari, Nintendo, Sega, etc.)

*If you remove the hard drive from your computer, please place the caddy and/or any screws back into the case.











Data Destruction

At LakeCity Reboot we respect your concerns regarding privacy and take detailed steps to ensure the data that has been stored on your computer is erased. Please see below for a description of the steps we take to ensure your device's data will be erased.

- Hard drives, solid state drives, flash drives, memory cards and similar re-writable media can usually be wiped as long as they are still in working order and should be wiped with a suitable program if that is the case; if not, the media will be physically destroyed.
- Read-only factory finished discs containing useful software should be stored with the other software and noted on the appropriate line of the Reboot Donation Inventory Sheet.
 - o All other discs should be destroyed as described elsewhere in this document.
- Once all similar media representing a line on the Reboot Donation Inventory Sheet is wiped, stored as software or destroyed then the current date which the donation has finished being processed on should be noted in that line.
- Programs which can make at least one pass across a media and write either zeros or pseudorandom data to every sector or block should be sufficient for wiping a media.
 - o The program should be configured to wipe the entire media and not just a partition.
 - Recommended media wiping software/utilities described elsewhere in this document include:
 - DBAN
 - dd
